

## Criteria for Admission

Criteria for admission to the Margaretan Program is based on the following, but not limited to:

The student possesses average or above-average intelligence.

The student has difficulty in processing learning tasks which may be related to learning disabilities. Documentation will be requested.

The student possesses demonstrated work habits and behavior which indicate the potential to success in a College Preparatory Program. The school reserves the right to contact previous teachers.

The student is willing to attend a 6 week Summer Program in Reading, Math and Study Skills.

All students are accepted into this program on a probationary basis. Students admitted to this program are expected

to treat everyone with respect and dignity, be actively and productively involved in the total academic program and attend regularly.



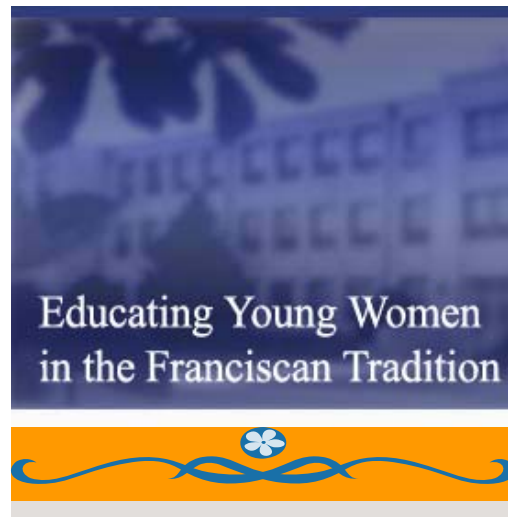
## COSTS

# Margaretan Scholars

The Margaretan Program, named for the foundress of the Sisters of St. Francis of Christ the King, was developed to provide instruction, guidance and support to those students experiencing learning difficulties because of specific learning needs. The student best served by this program is the intellectually able student experiencing academic difficulties due to a diagnosed disability, but who has the potential to succeed at the college level.



## Margaretan Objectives

Assist students in developing a healthy self-concept and a positive attitude toward learning and school.

Help students discover their unique talents, qualities and potential in a caring, peaceful environment.

Provide a quality college prep academic program with attention to instruction appropriate to the student's specific learning needs within the regular curriculum. As an example, the content may be delivered at a slower pace, with more supplemental activities to accentuate key mastery concepts rather than specific details.

Provide assistance in developing organizational skills and study skills.

## Curriculum

The curriculum is based on 24 credits over a 4 year period. Students can be in the Margaretan Program for four years, however the goal is to mainstream students as soon as they can work successfully as an independent learner.
